EARLY NUMBER SENSE

Matching numbers with sets of objects helps development of the "sense" for a number, "the threeness of 3".

Try these activities with your child

Label each cup in an egg carton with the numbers 1-12. Count out the right number of an item, pennies for example, for each cup. Guess how many pennies you used. Then count to see if the guess was close.

Line up five or more favorite toys. Which one is first? Second? Fifth? Count them in order: first, second, third, and so on.

Think of items in the home that can be matched with number 1 to 10. For example, one stove, two telephones, three beds, and so on. This can be done over several days. Keep a record by drawing pictures of the items that were found.
