Thank you for your cooperation.

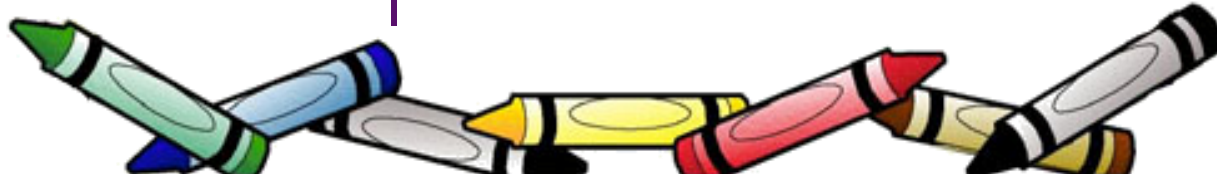
Here are a few reminders for parents of 3 & 4 year olds:

### Sick Policy

Regrettably it is inevitable that children are going to get sick. When children are in a group setting, they will undeniably get sick more often. Making a decision that a child is "too sick" to attend school can be a complex one. All of us, parents and staff, have a shared concern in the children's health and welfare. A sick child does not belong at school. We cannot give sick children the one-on-one attention they need.

Below are the sick guidelines:

If your child is sick, please keep him or her at home. If you child has fever, diarrhea, upset stomach, lice, eye infection, all skin rashes, runny nose showing greenish/yellowish nasal mucus, sever cold, or symptoms such as a major ear infections or any communicable disease, please DO NOT send him/her to school.
